The Ohio State Comprehensive Burn Center provides specialized care for patients with multiple types of thermal, inhalation, and soft tissue injuries as well as reconstruction for scarring in healed burns. In the past year, we have cared for over 400 inpatient burn patients and have had over 2,200 outpatient clinic visits. We have also performed over 150 laser treatments annually for burn survivors to help reduce scarring, pain, itching and nerve pain. As the only American Burn Association Adult Verified burn center in Columbus, our goal is to treat survivors of burns from the time of injury with their daily activities and eventual integration back to work.

The monies raised by the SFPE Golf Outing have benefited our patients and staff in the following ways:

- Assisting with burn compression garments for patients who do not have the resources to pay for these without our assistance. Compression garments help lessen the appearance and impact of the scars after recovery.
- Providing training for our SOAR (Survivors Offering Assistance in Recovery) program and supporting our monthly survivor group outings. We are also working on having the inpatients involved with the survivors so they can ask questions while still in the hospital, to help provide the inpatients with the sense of hope seeing survivors thrive after their injuries.
- Sponsoring trainee travel to the American Burn Association meeting in order to share novel research into burns and recovery.
- Burn survivor functions which bring together the nursing staff, first responders and burn survivors to celebrate their successes in recovery.

We at the Burn Center are so appreciative for the ongoing generosity of SFPE and those that support *the* annual Golf Outing to improve the lives of our burn survivors on a daily basis.

The Burn Center at Nationwide Children's Hospital is an all-inclusive program dedicated to providing best outcomes to pediatric burn patients. Campers enjoy activities such as woodshop, archery, fishing, arts and crafts and most importantly, making new friends.
